Rafael Scarfullery is a Christian classical guitarist, composer, orchestral/choral conductor, organist and therapeutic musician. He teaches guitar at Sweet Briar College and Randolph College, is the music director at the Aldersgate United Methodist Church in Charlottesville, and is a musician-in-residence at the UVA Hospital.
